## 1) Fund 60

- a. This account is made up of all fundraised money for each school building.
  - i. None of the funds are tax dollars.
  - ii. The amount varies. Buildings that have been around longer tend to have more money in them than newer buildings.
- b. The committee discussed the need for a plan regarding carry over, spending concerns, and inequities.
- c. The committee agreed to leave Fund 60 operating as it is now and continue monitoring it moving forward.

# 2) Preschool Indicators

 Andree Hayes, Principal of the Preschool Center and Transition Academy was present to discuss Preschool indicators and what is used to measure success.

#### i. Indicator 7: North Dakota Childhood Outcomes

- 1. When a child starts at ECSE, their IEP team works with the parents to give the child a rating 1 through 7 in certain areas.
  - a. Positive Social Relationships
  - b. Knowledge and Skills
  - c. The ability for the child to take appropriate actions to meet their needs (get around the classroom, speak for themselves, etc.)
- When the child moves either out of the district or up to kindergarten they are rated again and the goal would be to see growth from the beginning.

### ii. Indicator 12: Did we transition them appropriately on the timeline?

- 1. Do they have an IEP, did they start on their third birthday, etc.?
  - a. If we don't meet any of the criteria, we need to have a reason.
- b. The committee and administration discussed whether there would be other indicators we could create to measure success.

c. The administration will work to develop verbiage for new indicators the board will be able to monitor as part of their reports and bring them back to a future Governance Committee meeting.

### 3) DR 2 Preview

- a. Dr. Burgad discussed with the board the next monitoring report DR 2 Choice Ready.
  - i. This report will be presented to the board for action on October 12, 2020.
